

# Expand your iPhone 15 storage by transferring files to your compatible SanDisk® USB flash drive or portable SSD<sup>1</sup>.

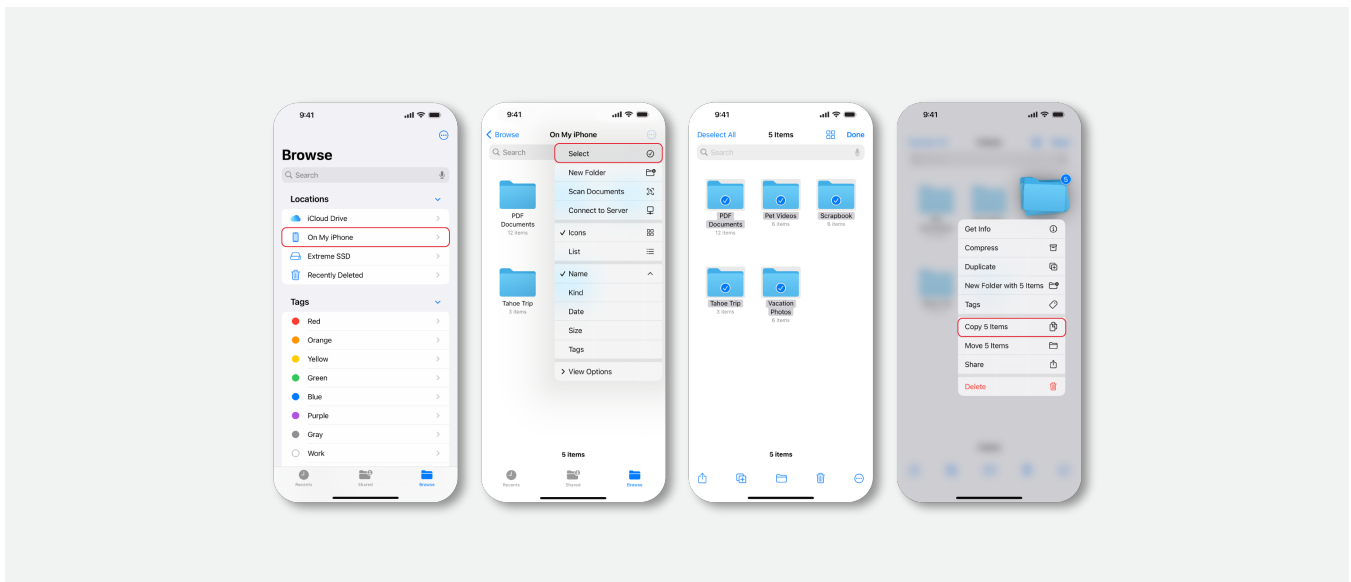
## Plug it in.

Connect your compatible SanDisk USB Type-C™ flash drive or portable SSD<sup>1</sup> to your iPhone's USB Type-C™ connector. Once plugged in, open your iPhone's Files app. To find your drive, tap "Browse." You should see your SanDisk drive under "Locations."



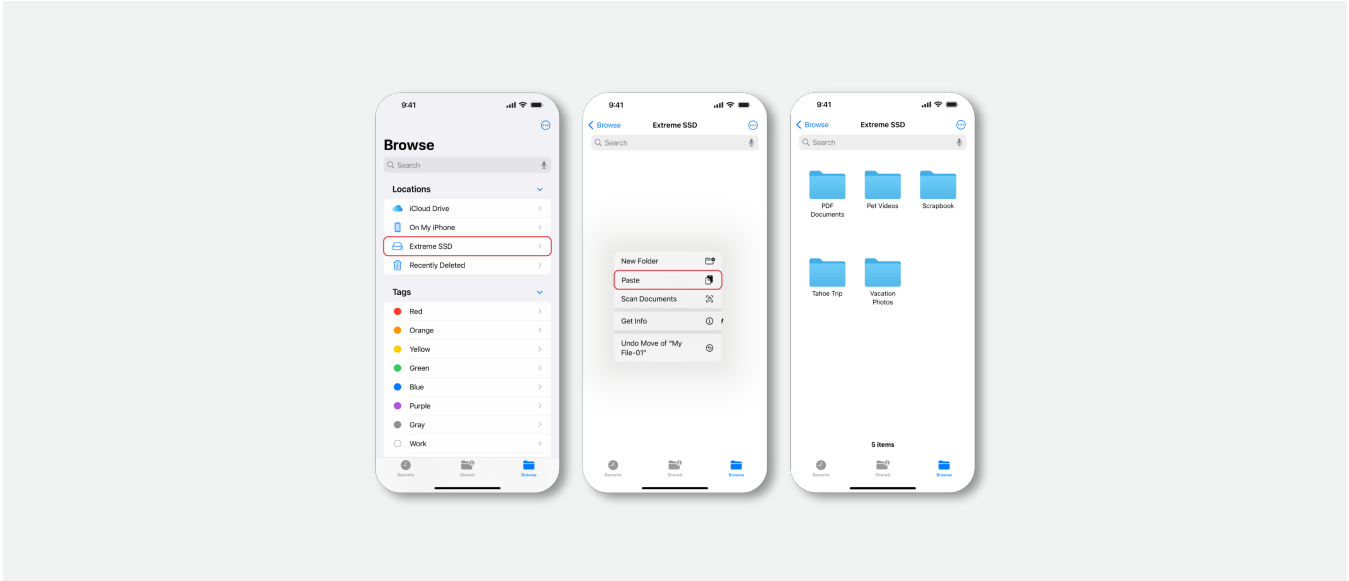
## Select your files.

Under "Locations," tap "On My iPhone" to see the files stored on your phone. Tap and hold a file, and tap "Copy" to copy it to your clipboard. (To copy multiple files, press the ⋮ icon in the top right corner and tap "Select." Tap and hold one of the selected files and tap "Copy.")



## Transfer your content.

Tap “Back” > “Browse,” and select your SanDisk drive to open your external storage. Tap and hold again, and select “Paste” to transfer your selected files onto your SanDisk device. Note: Once pasted, your files will remain on your iPhone until you delete them.
